Speaking at the opening, Nigar Valiyeva gave information on the dictionary and noted comparative analysis of phraseological combinations in Azerbaijani, English, and Russian languages are important on several aspects. She highlighted that this analyses defines appropriateness of languages, as well as helps to conceive its semantic development correctly. It was noted that phraseological combinations in Azerbaijani, English and Russian languages and over 90 thousands of phraseological units were collected and used for the first time at the two-volume dictionary each one of which has 988 pages.
