Shortly the results of centralized test exams on the general secondary education level (IX grade) will be posted in this section.

It should be noted that on February 12-13 in Baku were held centralized test exams on the general and complete secondary education level of 2010-2011 academic year.

26,730 students of classes XI passed the examinations in 72 centers, and 36,085 students of classes IX in 74 centers. Refugee pupils living in the city of Baku also took part in examinations held on February 12-13.

Examination for students of XI grades lasted three hours, and for IX grades half an hour.

There were applied a number of innovations at the test exams conducted in 2010-2011 academic year. Thus, the number of questions per subject was changed. The total number of questions on the Mother tongue and literature subject has been reduced from 25 to 21, on natural sciences was increased from 10 to 12. In addition, pupils was given a special pass sheet of the Ministry.

Representatives of PTA as observers watched the exam at 67 centres of Baku.

It should be noted that 137,523 pupils out of 236,710 are pupils of IX grades, 94,417 pupils in IX grades and 4,770 pupils of vocational lyceums will take part in the centralised test and final exams in 2010-2011 academic year.

Test exams at other regions of the country will start on February 20.
