Education Minister Misir Mardanov warmly welcomed the guest and noted the existence of fiftuitful relationship between Azerbaijan and Ukraine and also stressed the special role of education in these relations. The Minister underlined the feasibility of further development of bilateral relations and no noted the importance of widening the cooperation among universities, as well as in the secondary education field.
