At first, executive workers of education and teachers awarded with the Order of the President Ilham Aliyev visited the Alley of Honours to pay tribute to the memory of national leader Heydar Aliyev, and academician Zarifa Aliyeva, and lay a wreath at their tomb. Next, they visited the Alley of Martyrs to pay tribute to those who gave their lives for the Azerbaijan's independence and territory integrity.

Speaking at the opening ceremony, Education Minister Misir Mardanov congratulated teachers on Teachers' Day and wished them every success in their future activities. The Minister talked on care provided by the State for the education field, and underlined the education policy launched by the national leader Heydar Aliyev is successfully continued under the leadership of the President Ilham Aliyev. Noting the World Teachers' Day has been celebrated in Azerbaijan since 2004, the Minister estimated the Orders of the President on awarding a number of educators as an attention and care for the education field. He said that, since 1998, more than 2200 teachers have been awarded for their contribution to the development of Azerbaijani education.
