The ceremony was attended by the Education Minister Misir Mardanov, Head of Nizami District Executive Power Tahir Budagov, Executive Director of German-Azeri Business Association (DAWF) Florian Schroeder, CIS Director of KNAUF Academy Andrey Bykov, General Manager of KNAUF Marketing Baku, LLC Samir Guliyev, representative of the German Embassy in Azerbaijan Peter Ziegler, heads of KNAUF Group in Germany, Russia and Georgia and others.
