

Speaking at the opening of the meeting, Education Minister Misir Mardanov touched upon issues done by the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) in recent years to improve the education and create an effective liaison between parents and teachers. Noting the main goal of the organization is to build close collaboration and good communication between parents and teachers, the Minister highly praised the events held by the organization in the mentioned direction. He highlighted the important duties laid upon this organization to build a civil society in Azerbaijan, improve the quality of education and authority of school.

Moreover, Education Minister stressed the importance of organizing the PTA activity more effectively and underlined the appropriateness to study in this regard the practice of other countries. Sharifova also gave information on projects that PTA is taking part and measures implemented by the organization.

Moreover, T. Sharifova initiated the creation of affiliates of the PTA, development of mechanism to increase the sense of responsibility of parents, organization of Azerbaijan Teachers House for teachers to organize their communication and exchange of practical experience, etc. She also talked on some problems and difficulties faced by their organization.
