Exams for positions of physical training teacher and head of pre-conscription military training of youth started on July 23. According to the exam results, 110 candidates have been recruited to become physical training teachers, as well as 39 to heads of pre-conscription military training of youth.

It should be noted that, the competition for recruitment of teachers to vacant posts is conducted at three levels and in a centralised manner. 116 195 candidates for 3270 unfilled posts have submitted an e-application for the first level that will be held from 1 to 15 July. Their indicators for educational achievements have been assessed via the software programme, and 8728 applications have been rejected due to the inconsistency in specialty. As a result, the applications of 15467 candidates were confirmed, and they passed to the second level of the competition.

A majority of candidates, who was accepted to the second level of competition, are wishing to work as a primary school teacher. 339 candidates submitted their application for 143 vacant posts in Baku and 3764 candidates for 104 unfilled posts in other cities and regions. 2731 applicants submitted e-applications for English language teaching jobs, 2160 appliers for Azerbaijan language and literature, 1483 for Mathematics, and 1112 for History teacher jobs.

The most vacant posts are offered for Geography teacher jobs (21 in Baku, 407 in other cities and regions). 646 applicants received a right to participate in the second level on this specialty.
