8 of Azeri pupils, who took part in the festival, were representing Baku European Lyceum, 2 -You Young Talents Lyceum of Baku State University and others - Baku Private Turkish Lyceum d'Cag" OgOgretim dsletmeleri, School-Lyceum Ankara Mektebi, schools No5159 and 167 of Baku and School-Lyceum "Dafina" of Masalli district.
