The number of hours devoted to teaching English at school will be 5 hours per week. Moreover, Information Science subject will be taught 3 hours per week

The study at the school will be organized based on the Harvard University program. All conditions for extra-curricular activity of students were provided. There is a special room for students that will participate in driving courses from the 8th grade as well. The assessment will be conducted on a 50-point scale and each student will be able to track its results by using their personal development cards.
