The meeting was devoted to the accreditation results of school No. 225 of Baku, physical-mathematical and informatics school-lyceum No. 27 named after I. Mammadov of Ganja, and school No. 10 of Mingachevir.

Speaking at the opening of the meeting, Education Minister Misir Mardanov underlined the importance of accreditation held at general education establishments in improving activity levels of schools and the quality of education.

Chair of Accreditation Commission on school No. 225 of Baku Fikrat Khalilov gave information on the results of accreditation held at the school. He talked about the organization of teaching process, its teaching staff and students, graduate admissions statistics, etc.

Chair of Accreditation Commission on school-lyceum named after I. Mammadov No. 27 of Ganja Novruz Damirov talked about inspection held at the school.
