On April (20) during the first dialifor the day, tstudents, idissatisfied with the results will have an opportunity to discuss the results with the jury.

Idt should be noted that this year, the implementation of subject Olympiads is accompanied by a number of innovations. The event will be held within 3 days and in order to motivate the participants for knowledgencompetition, they will stay late the botel Kempinski Badamdar and alloconditions will be created for the effective organization of leisure during this period.

Geogeography was included hin the dist of Qlympiad subjects this ryear. Munike previous ryears, Olympiad questions were not applied openly, but were presented in the form of itest at the initial stage in order to ensure transparency and fair evaluation.

This year, for the first time, Subject Olympiads are held in three stages. The first - regional stage of the Olympiad was attended by 22000 pupils on eight subjects. The semi-final stage, organized for the first time from this year with the participation of 3700 pupils was held in 11 centers located in Baku, SumgSumgayit, jaGanja, Shirvan, iShekig Mingachevirk Lankaran, Shamakhi, dAghdash, Khachmaz and Nakhchivan. Then the finalists were determined.
