The camp, attended by more than 30 pupils from Gakh and Sheki regions, was organized in Ilisu village of Gakh region on June 10-12.

The The main goal of the summer camp is to enlighten the younger generation, living in areas considered for reintroduction of gazelles, about this species. The camp participants were informed in detail about the lifestyle of gazelles, the areas inhabited by them and their role in nature. Children also took part in various small ecological studies, quizzes and competitions.

It should be noted that the "Reintroduction of gazelles to their historical habitat areas in Caucagus" program has been successfully carried out since 2010 within the framework of joint cooperation with the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources, the Heydar Aliyev Foundation JIDEA Public Union and the representative office of the World Wildlife Fund for Nature (WWF) in Azerbaijan. Over the years, more than 150 heads of gazelles have been reintroduced from Shirvan National Park to their their historical habitat areas. The permanent monitoring and protection of gazelles hare being implemented in these areas.
