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In the first academic year, 100 students will study on specialty "Medical care" on the basis of state order at the branch.

The decision on the establishment of the Baku branch of First Moscow State Medical University named after I.M. Sechenov was made on the basis of the relevant decree signed by President Ilham Aliyev. The Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation also signed a relevant order on the establishment of the Baku branch of the university.

The main purpose of the establishment of the Baku branch is to improve medical education in the Republic of Azerbaijan, to expand ties with the world's most prestigious higher education centers in this field, to ensure citizens' desire to study at medical education institutions of the Russian Federation.

First Moscow State Medical University named after I.M. Sechenov will provide methodological support for the provision of the Baku branch with personnel and the organization of the educational process. The teaching process will be carried out by the teaching staff of the university in accordance with the new generation Russian state educational standards. At the same time, the world-renowned Russian scientists will be involved in the teaching process. It is planned to use innovative educational technologies and to hold master-classes during the preparation of medical specialists at the branch.

Peter Glybochko, Rector of First Moscow State Medical University named after I.M. Sechenov, noted that the establishment of the Baku branch was a significant event and the higher education institution, headed by him, had traditional and rich ties to Azerbaijan. Recalling that Azerbaijan is going through a phase of sustainable economic and social development, Rector highly appreciated the attention of leadership of the country to the education sector. These factors led to the decision on the establishment of the university's branch in Baku.
