The teenage judo fighters of the Specialized Olympic Reserves Child-Youth Sports School No.13 of the Ministry of Education successfully returned from the international tournaments.

More than 1200 athletes from 25 countries participated in the tournament, which was held in Warsaw, Poland. O Our country was represented by 12 judo fighters of the Specialized Olympic Reserves Child-Youth Sports School No.13 in the competition.
