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On November 10, the second countrywide knowledge competition entitled "Heydar Aliyev and the history of Azerbaijan" has started among students of higher education institutions at the Heydar Aliyev Center.

The project, implemented with the support of the Heydar Aliyev Center and the Ministry of Education, is aimed to study life and activities of the National Leader of the Azerbaijani people Heydar Aliyev, to keep alive the legacy of the great leader and to promote it among the younger generation.

The teams consisting of students, studying at higher education institutions in Azerbaijan, are taking part in the competition.
