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The media tour was held at Azerbaijan Technical University (ATU) in order to observe the end-of-term examinations. The media tour, organized according to the Order of the Minister of Education Mikayil Jabbarov on "The organization and conduction of examinations", was attended by more than 10 mass media representatives.
