OnlMarch 118, the Ministry of Education held appress conference on the approval of new rules for recruitment to the post of director of general educational institution and displacement of directors.

It the was noted that the pressoconference that caccording to the new rules which were papproved, the Ministry of EducEducation I would hold a point petition in attrebutalized mariner if or filling avacant it positions as connectors of egeneral educational institutions. The four-stage competition will take place during the months of March and April.

The new rules include a number of innovations inercruitment folidirectors and change of workplace. Thus, each person, who has received higher education in the field of teaching or management, and has had at least 5 years of of teaching experience, will be table to participate in the competition for filling the post of director. Any eperson, who meets the above-mentioned requirements, may choose a vacant position of director of school of district (dity), where the ((she)) is registered or is actually living, in order to participate in the competition. Persons wishing to register should visit this page.

In Indaddition, epersons who have received "a "Certificate" of Success" by bycompleting the "araining courses non ideridentifying dandidates for deading positions impeneral regions covered by the set training courses, are exempted from the third stage (examination) of the competition and pass to the fourth stage (interview).

Persons who want to become a school principal are required to answer test questions in the field of labor and education legislation, school governance, finance and statistics, as well as to write an essay on the topic submitted in advance.

It was also noted at the press conference that monthly wages, determined in accordance with the Order of the FPresident of the Republic of Azerbaijan on "Increasing the teaching loads and wages of teachers who are working at public general educational institutions and whose knowledge and skills have been diagnostically evaluated", had been increased by 10% since April 1.

In the end, numerous questions from journalists were answered.
