On February 20, Minister of Education and Higher Education of the State of Qatar, Mohammed bin Abdul Wahed Al-Hammadi, who is on a visit in Azerbaijan, visited the Alley of Honors to lay a wreath at the tomb of national leader Heydar Aliyev.
